SIGN ON:

All competitors will be required to sign an indemnity form (Parent or guardian if competitor under 18 years) and must have and present a current MA National Junior (also JCP Logbook) or Senior National licence and proof of current club membership or have pre organised MA One Event Licence.

All riders must attend scrutineering with their Helmet. <u>Helmets with camera mounts attached</u> will not be accepted. As per MOMS Bar ends must be plugged and cross bar pads fitted.

PIT AREA:

A CLOSED PIT will operate for both days; there will be NO CAMPING, NO BBQ's, etc in this area. NO Exceptions! Remember you cannot take your bike out of the pit area after it enters unless authorised by the Clerk of Course or their assistant.

A reminder to riders and support crew that open footwear incl. thongs are not permitted in the pit area. Children under 12yo must be supervised and be with an adult at all times at the venue. As the event also includes Juniors there is NO Smoking at the venue as per State Law.

ALL RIDERS MUST HAVE A MIN 1KG FIRE EXTINGUISHER AVAILABLE TO THEM IN THIER PIT. IF SHARING A PIT TENT WITH ANOTHER RIDER THERE MUST BE AT LEAST 1 FIRE EXTINGUISHER PER TENT

COMPOLOSURY PIT STOPS

Please note the below rule does not apply for this event except for the Drybrakes which are permitted to be used.

COMPULSORY PITLANE ENTRY FOR CATERGORIES AND CLASSES:
JUNIORS 1-1.5HRS IN DURATION - ONE COMPULSORY STOP
ALL OTHER CLASSES 2-3HRS IN DURATION - TWO COMPULSORY STOPS
WHICH CAN BE TAKEN ANY TIME IN THE RACE. IF YOU DON'T DO YOUR
COMPULSORY PIT STOP/S YOU WILL RECEIVE A PENALTY THAT WILL BE
MEASURABLE TO THE OFFENCE. (See final instructions)

REFUELLING: DRY BRAKE TYPE OF FUELING SYSTEM CAN BE USED.

WALKING OF TRACKS:

ALL RIDERS may walk the tests after 11.00 am till 5pm Friday. Riders may walk Sunday's tests half an hour after completion of racing on Saturday.

CAMPING – (there is none)

There is no camping permitted at the track as requested by the property owner, camping is only permitted for the workers of the organising club and security as authorised by the property owner, there is accommodation available in Rawson, Erica, Moe etc. Gates to the venue will be open from 6:00am





PARKING

Please follow directions from CFA volunteers for parking arrangements, please consider giving them a Gold Coin donation for their support. Gates to the venue will be open from 6:00am Saturday and Sunday

REFUELING

Environmats must be used when replenishing any fluids, penalties will apply for non-compliance. Refuelling only in designated refuelling area. (Penalty is exclusion). All riders must dismount from the bike before refueling and engines must be stopped.

ENVIRONMENTAL:

ENVIRO MATS must be used when refueling – Environats in 2017 MUST measure 1m x 1.6m and be of approved absorbent material, <u>rubber backed</u> carpet is acceptable. Enviro mats available for sale \$15.00 at sign on.

ATTENTION ALL RIDERS

As per the GCRs <u>the use of goggle tear offs at off-road events is banned</u> as they are not biodegradable and are harmful to the environment, native animals and stock.

Sound testing will take place as per the 2017 MOM Section 14:15 and appendix C, machines over 110dBA + tolerance, 2dBA before race and 3dBApost race (venue has lower sound emission requirement than MOM, ref MOM Appendix C 1.1.2) may be excluded from the days racing at clerk of course discretion.

If any rider is sound tested at the completion of their sprint lap and fail the noise test they may be penalised by relegation of class position or excluded as per MOM.

PLEASE NOTE:

Dogs/pets and mini bikes (except those entered) are not permitted at the event.

CATERING

Will be available for breakfast and lunch Saturday and Sunday and will be supplied by local community groups.

RIDERS BRIEFING (is COMPULSORY) -

All riders (parent or guardian if under 18years) must attend, there will be a random roll call, any competitor not present will be fined

Format

Saturday 22nd April will be a Cross Country, in three separate races up to "X" number of laps as specified by the C of C to be announced at riders briefing.

Race 1 - JUNIORS, 2 hours

Race 2 - CLUBMAN, UNDER 19 B, WOMEN, 2 Hours (No Sighting Lap)

Race 3 - E1, E2, E3, EJ and Veterans 3 Hours (No Sighting Lap)

Sunday 23rd April will be Sprints with two separate tracks.





PRESENTATION:

Presentation will be held on Sunday for the event (both rounds) as soon as possible after racing. Riders must attend presentation in order to be entitled to any awards. Any riders who do not attend to receive their award will be fined. We ask that you dress in team/manufacturer or appropriate and presentable gear to accept you award.

COURSE SIZE AND TERRAIN

Cross Country Course Approximately 20 mins.

Sprint Course – 2 Courses approximately 8 mins each.

Terrain – OFF ROAD, Bush, Trees, Logs, Clay and a sprinkle of Grass!

Two arrows adjacent on the course are GATE course markers ie riders <u>MUST ALWAYS</u> pass between these arrows. Any slashed area <u>IS</u> the course, riders must not leave the slashed areas. We will be maintaining the course markings throughout the event, regardless of this, any deviation from the intended course is a breach of these instructions. Riders MUST stay on the "intent" of the course. No Deviation will be accepted.

TRANSPONDER HIRE:

Transponders will be available for collection on Saturday at Sign on.

Transponder brackets will not be hired – brackets will be for sale at sign on for \$15.00 please ensure you bring the correct money.

Please ensure you bring cable ties in order to secure your transponder & bracket to your motorcycle.

MEDICAL:

RACESAFE Medical Team will be at the track from 7am until half an hour after racing on both Saturday and Sunday. Dr Michael Thumm from RACESAFE will be the Chief Medical Officer (CMO). He and one other member of the medical team will be on Motorbikes patrolling the tracks to ensure the quickest possible response times. They will also have a mobile medical Centre set up for riders to be treated/ seen by further medical personnel.





LOCATION:

- THOMSON VALLEY RD, PARKERS CORNER/RAWSON (AMOR)

Directions:

From Moe head to Walhalla/Erica, go through Erica and go towards Rawson.

At the cross road at Parkers Corner (just past DSE office and new CFA station) go straight through cross road to Thomson Dam. (Do not turn right and go into Rawson).

About 1500m past the cross road on the left hand side is the gravel driveway with double gates to the start area. Look for some arrows or signs at the driveway.

At about "B" mark in the map linked below.

When entering the property please follow directions from CFA for parking, if everyone follows the directions given, the distance to your pit tent will be the minimum possible.

Parking to be strictly in designated areas only as the site is used 24/7 by a mining company for storage and access is required at all times.
